

Dr. Yuichi Moriguchi is Vice President of National Institute for Environmental Studies (NIES) in Japan since April 2019, and Emeritus Professor of the University of Tokyo upon retirement in March 2021.



He graduated from the Department of Sanitary and Environmental Engineering, Faculty of Engineering at Kyoto University. He holds Ph.D. in Engineering from Kyoto University. He joined the NIES in 1982, engaged in wide range of environmental research at NIES until 2011. After appointed to the Director of the Research Center for Material Cycles and Waste Management of NIES for 2005-2011, he moved to the University of Tokyo in 2011 as Professor in Urban Engineering. In his early career, he had also worked for the Environment Agency of Japan and for the OECD Environment Directorate in Paris. He chaired the Working Group on Environmental Information and Outlooks of the OECD for 2003-2008, contributed to the UNEP International Resource Panel for 2007-2016 as one of the inaugural members. He was awarded the 2013 Society Prize of International Society for Industrial Ecology. He is an associate member of the Science Council of Japan, and was the president of The Institute of Life Cycle Assessment for 2017-2021. His research field covers Industrial Ecology, Environmental Systems Analysis and Post-disaster environmental management.
